Additionally, RAFAEL complies with applicable conflict minerals standards and requirements across its supply chains.

As a responsible organization, we embed Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) principles into our activities, prioritizing diversity, inclusion, and minimizing environmental impact. RAFAEL regularly releases an ESG report and presents it in its public website and it is certified with Israeli Standard IS10000 - Social Responsibility Management System.
